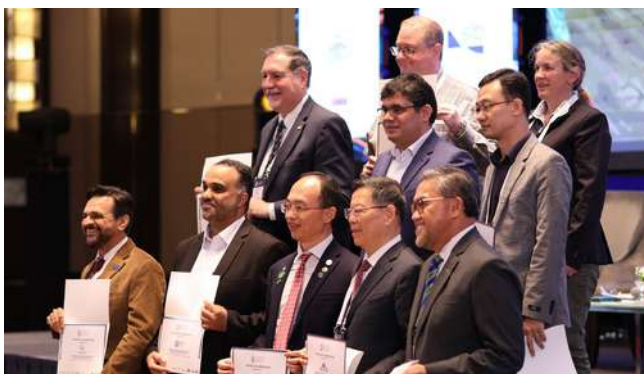


# MOGSC'S ROLE IN SUSTAINABILITY AT THE INAUGURAL IGS 2024 IN ASIA PACIFIC

## EXCLUSIVE ENGAGEMENT SESSION ON THE INDUSTRY TALENT FRAMEWORK (INTAF)



On 27 November 2024, at MoF Inc. Tower, the Malaysian Oil, Gas & Energy Services Council (MOGSC) and the Malaysia Petroleum Resources Corporation (MPRC) co-initiated an exclusive engagement session on the Industry Talent Framework (InTAF) – a key initiative under the National OGSE Industry Blueprint 2021-2030. The session provided a unique platform for connecting with key industry stakeholders, highlighting significant benefits for the OGSE sector.

Launched at the end of 2023 through a collaboration between MPRC, PETRONAS, and MOGSC, the InTAF initiative aims to develop a comprehensive framework that identifies and addresses critical skill gaps to ensure a future-ready workforce. The framework is designed to provide valuable insights into talent supply and demand, thereby enhancing manpower strategies, optimizing resource management, and supporting broader organizational goals.

During the pilot phase, the focus was placed on four key skillsets: Welder, Scaffolder, Mechanical Fitter, and Blaster & Painter. The session also emphasized a three-year Talent Demand Outlook centered on these areas and concluded with an interactive discussion addressing critical industry needs in the OGSE sector.

Outcome and Way Forward: Stakeholders shared insights and set immediate talent priorities, a working group will finalize the InTAF framework and develop a three-year talent strategy for four key skillsets, and future sessions will be scheduled to review progress and refine the framework.



# MAJLIS PELUNCURAN KERANGKA PEKERJAAN (OF) PERSATUAN INDUSTRI KESELAMATAN MALAYSIA



On 10th December 2025, MOGSC represented the oil and gas (O&G) industry as the lead body in witnessing the launch of the National Occupational Skills Standard for Safety Professionals across various industries in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

These collaborations resulted in the development of new training modules, enhanced certification processes, and increased industry participation in skills development programs. This collaborative effort aimed to establish a comprehensive ecosystem for talent and competency development, ensuring the industry remained competitive and well-equipped for future challenges.
