# MAYBANK AND MOGSC : BUMIPUTERA OGSE FINANCING INITIATIVE



On 23 July 2025, MOGSC met with Maybank to discuss a new financing programme for the Bumiputera OGSE sector the Business Supply Chain Tier Empowerment Fund (BSCEF).

The BSCEF aims to support Bumiputera vendors by improving their capabilities and competitiveness in high-value supply chains. It offers competitive profit rates and financing structures backed by better pricing and government guarantees, providing an alternative to conventional loans.

A survey has been shared with MOGSC members to gather feedback and ensure the programme addresses the real needs of Bumiputera OGSE companies.

# MOGSC ENGAGES WITH PUNB ON SPECIAL FINANCING FOR MOGSC MEMBERS



On 30 July 2025, MOGSC held a meeting with Perbadanan Usahawan Nasional Berhad (PUNB) to explore financing opportunities for MOGSC members.

PUNB proposed the development of a financing product offering a special rate exclusively for MOGSC members, distinct from its standard vendor financing rate. This preferential rate presents a valuable opportunity to strengthen financial accessibility and promote business growth within the OGSE sector.

Following the discussion, PUNB will review MOGSC’s proposal for a financing package modeled after the one extended to TNB vendors. Further updates on this initiative will be shared once the details are finalized stay tuned for upcoming announcements.

## COURTESY VISIT TO UNIVERSITI MALAYA: UM-INDUSTRY ENGAGEMENT DAY

He highlighted MOGSC’s efforts in advancing industry competitiveness, advocating for fair and transparent policies, and ensuring local companies are well-positioned to thrive both domestically and internationally.

The conversation covered a wide range of topics, including industry competitiveness, financing challenges, equitable contracting practices, capacity building, and the urgent need to develop globally competitive Malaysian OGSE champions. Ts. Syed Saggaf also spoke extensively about the sector’s role in supporting the national energy transition agenda, emphasizing that OGSE players must embrace innovation, sustainability, and digital transformation to remain relevant in an evolving global energy landscape.

A recurring theme throughout the episode was the importance of collaboration. Ts. Syed Saggaf stressed that stronger partnerships between the government, national oil companies, and industry players are crucial in creating a sustainable and future ready energy ecosystem. He also underscored the need for continuous talent development and knowledge sharing to ensure Malaysia remains a regional hub for energy services excellence.

The episode received significant attention from industry stakeholders and the public alike, with many praising the candid yet forward-looking tone of the discussion. It reinforced MOGSC’s standing as a proactive advocate for the OGSE community one that is dedicated to shaping a resilient, competitive, and sustainable energy future for Malaysia.

# MOGSC AT THE NATIONAL BUDGET 2026 ENGAGEMENT SESSIONS



The Malaysian Oil, Gas & Energy Services Council (MOGSC) was invited to participate in several of government ministries' budget 2026 engagement sessions.

On 7 August 2025, we participated in the Budget 2026 Engagement Session with YAB Datuk Seri Anwar bin Ibrahim, Prime Minister and Minister of Finance, together with YB Senator Datuk Seri Amir Hamzah Azizan, Second Minister of Finance.

The session gathered over 300 representatives from government agencies, GLCs, trade associations, and NGOs. During the dialogue, Ts. Syed Saggaf, President of MOGSC, presented key industry recommendations and expressed appreciation to the government for adopting several of MOGSC's earlier proposals - including support for Sapura Energy and the revamp of levy collection to enhance talent development within the energy sector.

MOGSC reaffirmed its support for Malaysia's energy transition and Net Zero 2050 goals, while highlighting the continued importance of the traditional oil and gas services segment, which is projected to contribute 78% of the energy mix by 2050.

In another session on 12 Sept 2025 with the Ministry of Investment, Trade and Industry (MITI), chaired by its minister YB Senator Datuk Seri Utama Tengku Zafrul Aziz, MOGSC Vice President, En Zahris, requested for seed allocation for the OGSE sector to support its growth, business expansion, project financing and R&D activities, to allow the sector to be more independent and less reliant on government support in the future.

All in all, for the 2026 Budget, we urged for enhanced financial allocation and targeted incentives to strengthen funding and liquidity for OGSE players, ensuring the sector continues to play a vital role in Malaysia's economic growth.



## SARAWAK OIL & GAS INDUSTRY CAPABILITY COUNCIL (SOG-ICC) MEETING



The Sarawak Oil & Gas Industry Capability Council (SOG-ICC) convened its second meeting on 25 September 2025 in Kuching, Sarawak. The Malaysian Oil & Gas Services Council (MOGSC) was invited to participate as a committee member, represented by Mr. Zahris Sham, Vice President of MOGSC.

The meeting was chaired by Mr. Ismail Saad, Council Chairman and Senior Vice President of Human Capital, Corporate Relations & Services at PETROS. The Council plays a pivotal role in promoting and supporting the sustainable development of talent within Sarawak's oil and gas industry. Its primary objective is to ensure a strong pipeline of competent and skilled Sarawakian professionals to meet the state government's aspiration of creating quality employment opportunities and advancing Sarawak's energy transition agenda.

Discussions during the meeting focused on strategies to increase Sarawakian participation in the industry, particularly in skilled workforce segments. The Council also reviewed findings from its latest commissioned study and explored initiatives to attract young talents to the industry, emphasizing early engagement and career awareness among students.

## MOGSC PARTICIPATED IN THE NATIONAL OGSE BLUEPRINT STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING



On 26th September 2025, the Malaysian Oil & Gas Services Council (MOGSC) participated in the National OGSE Blueprint Steering Committee Meeting organized by the Malaysia Petroleum Resources Corporation (MPRC) and the Ministry of Economy.

The session brought together key stakeholders from various government ministries, agencies, and industry representatives including PETRONAS, PETROS, and MOGSC. 


